The Path of the Righteous

During my daily Bible reading I came across this passage, "But the path of the righteous is like the light of the dawn, that shines brighter and brighter until the full day. (Proverbs 4:18, NASB)" I think the writer is suggesting that as those who follow God's righteousness will grow more and more as they walk in that path.

The writer is instructing his son (4:10) in which path to follow throughout his life. It is the path of wisdom (4:11). He encourages his son to take hold of the instruction and not let go (4:13). He tells his son that wisdom is his life (4:13). He then tells him to not enter the path of the wicked (4:14). The path of the wicked is darkness (4:19) and will cause stumbling. This path robs one of sleep (4:16). It is also filled with violence (4:17).

In contrast if one follows the path of wisdom, they can walk and run without falling (4:12). There is nothing to keep one from living a full life (4:10) when they follow the instruction in righteousness. The writer then in the passage I quoted above tells his son that if he will consistently follow the path of righteousness then he will grow in his ability to actually be righteous and that his growth will be visible to all just like the sun at the brightest part of the day.

I realize that my walk on that righteous pathway is still growing. I am glad to know that as I obey God's word I will get better and better in my walk. I am encouraged to keep learning and keep growing in my walk. I hope you are as well. I hope that every day you will something new about God's word and God's path. I also hope that your growth gets brighter and brighter.
