Complicated

Life today seems complicated to me. Right now, a good portion of our country are steep into their taxes. I am as well. And there are new details that make my taxes more complicated. My electronic watch isn't functioning properly. What settings did I accidentally change? Or did the company mess up its latest update with the software? My work seems to have new situations pop up every week that keep me on my toes, although I don't always keep up very well. The list goes on and on.

In my daily Bible reading I'm currently in the book of Numbers. In Chapters Eight through Ten, Moses describes the work that each clan of the Levites must do in breaking down the entire Tabernacle and transporting it to the next location. God's cloud will guide them to each location. In Chapter Ten they leave Mount Sinai and begin their journey to the Promised Land.

I got to thinking about breaking down the Tabernacle and how difficult that must be. The right clan must do the right tasks. Then the right clan must carry on poles or transport on wagon the right furniture, coverings, poles, and utensils. The cloud will show them when to stop. Then the Levities must assemble the Tabernacle. Again, each clan must do its part properly. The Tabernacle is, in essence, a tent to us, which may seem simple. But if you read Exodus 25-31, you will see that it has a lot of parts. I wonder if each leader of the three clans of Levities worried about getting everything assembled or broken down properly. They probably saw the whole operation as complicated.

My life may have different components than Israel's life in Moses' day, but complication was present then and today. I'm pretty sure that sin entering the world through Adam made life complicated for us. We contribute to that complication through our imperfections. It is good to know that we can gain rest from our complications in Jesus (Matthew 11:28).
