Change

I recently read an article about the reasons why worship services are changing. Worship services in other churches have changed a lot since I became a Christian in 1973. There were lots of reasons and forces at work in our country that brought about the changes. I remember reading about the "worship wars" in other churches. I thought I would share with you three reasons from the article, but I will add my thoughts about why those reasons are changing us.

The first is "generational shift." In the past, generations have come and gone without change. The difference I think today is that we send our kids to college, which means they get exposed to other ideas. They like those ideas and bring those ideas into their churches, which creates a different atmosphere in worship. In eras past, kids didn't grow up and leave their home. They were trained by their parents and the local community. So, change didn't happen that rapidly. And even if the kids don't go off to college today, TV and the Internet make it possible for them to experience new ideas from the privacy of their own homes.

With generational change comes "new leaders." Leaders who are strong willed have often brought change about. The new leaders today are part of the generational exodus that occurs when they go off to college or just move to a different city. Our fellowship has gone through some changes because new leaders pop up and assert their views. Sometimes those changes are for the good, but not always.

The last reason for change is "technology." We no longer just amplify the preacher, but we record him and even stream him live on any number of Internet programs. This brings a whole slew of ideas that we can do to enhance the service. Some think this makes worship more meaningful, but over time we learn that we must be more careful as to how we implement technology.

We are experiencing some changes in our worship services. We do it to help those from different countries. I hope our changes result in rejoicing in the Lord who has helped us and blessed us in many ways.
