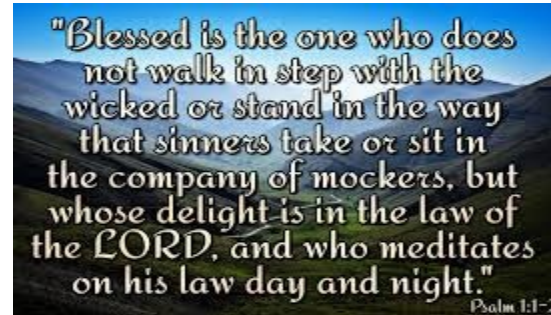

I'm still worried that our country is headed down the wrong road. I'm still worried about who is getting elected. I know that there are others in this country who worry about these things as well. But their approach is to get the right people into office and pass the right laws. I side with them as an American. But I realize that I am still responsible to serve my God first and foremost. I am not going to help people find Jesus by preaching my brand of politics. I'm going to pray for our country and its leaders. I am going to help the people I meet find Jesus first.

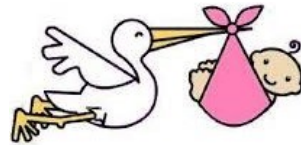
