

There is a home exercise company named Peloton. Their initial goal was to make a stationary bike (other machines were produced later) for the home, with a screen that allows you to connect with a trainer. The reason for this model is to give those who don't have time to drive to a gym the feel of a gym. The company was looking to tap into those who want motivational trainers and classes but can't get to a gym. The company initially grew and developed what some called a "cult-like" following. However, the company soared when the pandemic hit. People couldn't go to the gym, so they bought Peloton's equipment. Peloton's capital was \$6 billion at the beginning of the pandemic and rose to \$50 billion at the pandemic's height. Their stock prices soared as well. Then the pandemic ended and so did their success. Since December 2020 the company has not posted a profit. Their CEO just stepped down and 15% of employees were laid off.

I'm sure there are a lot of reasons for this fall, but I think one of the reasons is that most of the people they gained during the pandemic were people who like being around other people. These folks wanted a direct human connection, not a screen connection. These folks didn't want to be home alone, they wanted to be with other people exercising and having fun. They wanted a real connection.

I'm sure that this reason is found in many other situations as well. People want a real human connection and not a screen. So why did churches not gain back all those they lost during the pandemic? Maybe some folks figured out that their church didn't give them a real connection. Perhaps their church didn't make them feel connected to God and to each other.

The church is people, not a building. Everyone needs to do his or her part (Ephesians 4:16). I hope that when people visit, we all try to connect with them so we can help them feel connected to God and to us. We will tap into their need for fellowship.
