The Gospels

The Gospel According to Matthew has five blocks of the teachings of Jesus (Chapters 5-7, 10, 13, 18, 23-25). It appears that Matthew is presenting Jesus as the New Moses. Moses had five books of teaching and Jesus has five books as well, according to Matthew. Matthew also has more Old Testament quotations showing Jesus fulfilling the promises concerning the Messiah that God made to various people in the Old Testament .

The Gospel According to Mark writes about the activity of Jesus. One of Mark's favorite words is "immediately" or "straightway" (KJV word). When Jesus does something, Mark shows that he immediately goes on to the next activity. Mark also has all but one or two miracles before Peter's confession of Jesus as the Christ (Mark 8:29). Mark is presenting the power and authority of Jesus in his activity to show that he is the Messiah/Christ so that you, as the reader, will be led to Peter's conclusion.

The Gospel According to Luke has a focus on the poor and outcasts of society. When Luke records Jesus' visit to the synagogue in Nazareth (Luke 4:16-30), Jesus quotes from Isaiah 61:1-2, which says that the Messiah will proclaim good news to the poor, the captives, the blind, and the oppressed. Jesus gives hope to everyone, not just the well off.

The Gospel According to John is different from the other three. His gospel is often called "the heavenly" or "spiritual" Gospel. John records several places where Jesus uses the words "I AM" (e.g. John 8:12, 24), to show that Jesus is God in the flesh (John 1:1, 14). John also emphasizes eternal life (John 3:15). John also records Jesus teaching the 12 about more than the Lord's Supper on that final night (John 13-17).

Every Gospel has a different flavor and emphasis to cover all that God wants us to know about Jesus as our Messiah/Christ. This helps us to reach different people who may be attracted to different aspects of Jesus. Together, the four Gospels proclaim the good news to the world.

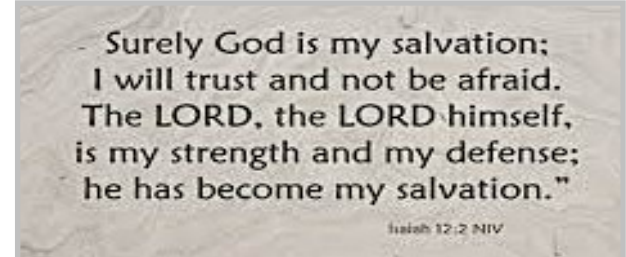
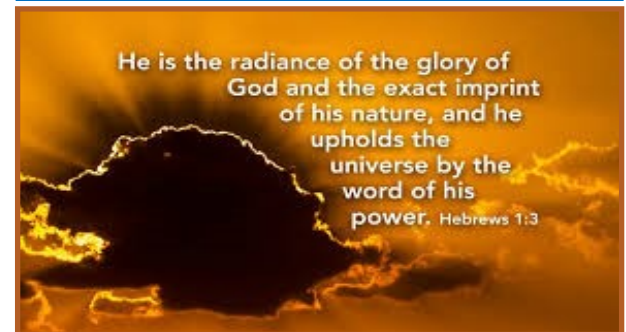
