#### The Promised Land

God promised Abraham that his descendants would one day inhabit the land where he currently resided (Genesis 15:12-16). Abraham was currently residing in what we call "the land of Canaan." The land was ruled by several tribes that we often give a single designation to as "Canaanites." God promised that even though his descendants would live in a foreign land for a while, they would come back to the land of Canaan full of possessions.

Several hundred years later, Moses led the descendants of Abraham out of Egypt as the beginning of their journey to this land of promise. Their first stop was Mt. Sinai where they received the covenant that God was making with them. Even though they at first broke the most basic commandment (worshipping another god), God forgave them and moved forward with their journey. The Book of Numbers records Israel's leaving Mt. Sinai and heading to the promised land.

Not long after they started, they were told by God to send 12 men to the land to spy it out. The men brought back produce to show how fruitful the land was. But 10 of the men also reported that the people were too big and too strong for Israel. They recommended that they go back to Egypt. The Israelites as a whole rebelled against Moses and God. Well, that was the final straw for God. He decided that the older generation (over 20) would not enter the land.

The reason the reaction of the Israelites kept them from the promised land was that it betrayed a lack of trust (Hebrews 3:16-19) in the Lord and His ability to help them overcome the obstacles of entering the promised land. There is still a promised land waiting for us (Hebrews 4:1-2). There are still difficulties in our journey. We need to trust in the Lord to help us arrive.
