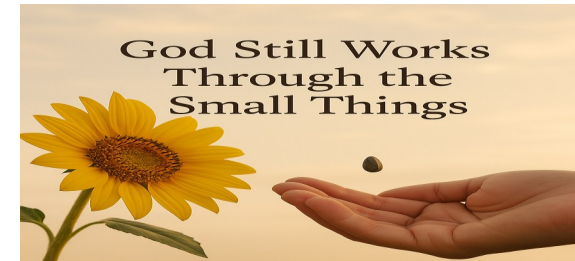

We live in a world that applauds the big, the visible, the spectacular. Yet the Bible is full of moments when God chooses the small to accomplish great things. This reminds us that His power doesn't depend on how much we have, but on the faith which we place in His hands.

When the prophet Elijah faced a severe drought, it wasn't a storm that signaled the coming rain, but **a small cloud the size of a man's hand** (1 Kings 18:44). That tiny sign brought hope—and soon after, a mighty rain followed. That's how God works!

Jesus Himself taught that **“the kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed,”** which, though it is the smallest of seeds, grows to become a large tree (Matthew 13:31–32). In God’s hands, what seems small has eternal potential.

Maybe today you feel like your service is insignificant, your prayers are simple, or your resources are few. But remember: **“Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,” says the Lord of hosts**” (Zechariah 4:6). God loves to use what the world considers little to display His glory.

Don't underestimate the small acts of obedience, a word of encouragement, a moment in prayer for someone else, or simply showing love. Because through the small, God continues to move with great power.

So don't stop. Don't lose heart. Your seed of faith, your act of love, your quiet prayer—none of it goes unnoticed by God. He is writing eternal stories with hands just like yours. Trust that what may seem small today will one day be a testimony of His greatness.

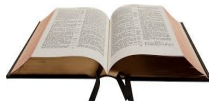
