There's Always Opposition to the Word of God

Every year, on the first Thursday of May, many believers in the United States gather to observe the **National Day of Prayer**—a moment to humbly seek God's guidance for our nation. In contrast, the same day is also recognized by some as the **National Day of Reason**, promoted by humanists, atheists, and secularists as a response to what they consider a violation of the separation between church and state.

This stark contrast is a reminder of a truth found throughout Scripture: **there is always opposition to the Word of God.**

But here's the surprising truth: opposition isn't always bad.

Jesus said, "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first" (John 15:18). From the days of the prophets through the persecution of the early church, and even today, God's people have faced resistance. But that opposition has often served to strengthen faith, sharpen truth, and refine commitment.

When challenged, believers are pushed to know the Scriptures deeper, to defend their faith with love and clarity, and to live in a way that reflects the light of Christ in a dark world.

Paul reminds Timothy, "Everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted" (2 Timothy 3:12). But that doesn't lead us to fear—it leads us to **stand firm**. Opposition shows us the value of what we believe and draws a clear line between truth and error.

So, when society pushes back, let us not be discouraged. Let us be rooted. Let us walk according to the Word—not just in church, but in schools, workplaces, and homes.

Because the more the world resists, the more we are reminded: **the Word of God is alive, powerful, and worth standing for.**
